This is a very nice piece of work. I would like to encourage the authors to publish some of the results in numerical form, e.g. in tables in the supplementary material. In particular, the long records from Cape Grim should become publicly available in numerical form. This will help in future studies on these compounds, for later comparisons with other studies, and to provide easy access to data for people who e.g. write the climate reports etc. It would also be very valuable to tabulate the emissions data. Also for now, there is not a single emission number mentioned in the text, which I find a bit disturbing.
