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Comment

Interactive comment on “Atmospheric removal times of the aerosol-bound radionuclides ^{137}Cs and ^{131}I during the months after the Fukushima Dai-ichi nuclear power plant accident – a constraint for air quality and climate models” by N. I. Kristiansen et al.

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Following the observation-based aerosol lifetime estimates from this study, there is now a need to compare these findings with aerosol lifetimes obtained by models.

We therefore encourage modellers to perform simulations of the release of aerosol-bound radionuclides emitted from the Fukushima Dai-ichi nuclear accident in 2011, and kindly ask you to contribute to a comparison study of modelled and observed
