It would have been very interesting to also include the effect of continuous total-column xCO₂ observations on the network. A number of ground-based FTIR stations in Europe already contribute such data as part of the Total Carbon Column Observing Network (TCCON). Most of them have also contributed to the IMECC project.

I understand that this would probably be beyond the scope of this article but might be an interesting idea for a follow-up study.
