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The authors use a Bayesian approach to better understand the behaviour of an chemistry-climate model with regards to CCN.

This is one of the best applications of Bayesian statistical methods I have seen in climate modelling. The study is well conceived and the conclusions are very clear. The paper is extremely well written and it is hard to even find a minor fault. It is impressive that the analysis told the modellers things about their model that they didn't understand themselves.

I am usually a pretty harsh reviewer so it is very rare for me to say this, but I feel the paper is acceptable in its present format. An excellent paper.
