

We have added the following text in Section 2.3 (lines 214-219):

“Use of lower accommodation coefficient values results in shifting of the estimated volatility distributions to higher values. Lee et al. (2010) explored this sensitivity and estimated that an order of magnitude change in the mass accommodation coefficient was “equivalent” to a corresponding change in the volatility distribution. Similar conclusions about the sensitivity of the estimated volatility to the accommodation coefficient were reached by Cappa and Jimenez (2010) as well as Riipinen et al. (2010).”
