Biomass burning is an important air pollution source in the Tibetan Plateau and can also be a significant source of Na in wet deposition. The use of Na as the tracer of sea-salt does not sound scientific. Construction can be a source of Ca, but this reviewer is not sure the importance in the Tibetan Plateau. The authors are encouraged to clarify this. Overall, Section 4.2 does not make any sense to this reviewer and needs revision.
