Erik Stabenau asks what observations in the next decade or so would verify our assumptions. Steven Marcus suggests that our paper would have greater appeal and impact if it featured some notable, verifiable predictions.

These are both helpful comments, which will be reflected in our revised paper. In addition, a more direct response may be useful here, because it is impractical to add much detail to an already long paper. This allows us to also address some popular misconceptions about our paper and to write in a language that more of the public can understand.
