

Interactive comment on “Tropospheric ozone over Equatorial Africa: regional aspects from the MOZAIK data” by B. Sauvage et al.

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I would like to quickly point out the fact that you may have not read the good version of the paper. We had some troubles with the posted version at the beginning of the discussion phase, partly because of too long figures. At first, the online version didn't have all the proper figures and captions (Fig 3, 5 and 9 for example were not complete). Of course, it's a little bit of our fault because we haven't checked carefully enough before accepting the publication. Anyway, we exchanged several e-mails with the editor office and we ended up having the correct version on the web site a few days later. The problem came back this morning with your comments. You obviously didn't work on the good version of the paper because you are complaining about missing figures and captions. We think that some of your major comments (especially the general one) are related to the bad understanding of the paper because of these missing information.

Before answering in detail all the points you raised, would you agree to reconsider some of your judgments after having another read of the good version now available on the web site ?
