

## ***Interactive comment on “Twenty-five years of continuous sulphur dioxide emission reduction in Europe” by V. Vestreng et al.***

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Understanding Problem: Page 5123, line 10:

I do not understand the meaning of the sentence: " In recent years , the lowermost uncertainty level is equally large to the annual European sulphur reduction (Fig. 5)". What is the intention of this sentence by the authors ? Fig. 5 describes the Number of countries with emission increases from one year to another. But at a first view there is no relationship recognizable to the uncertainties in trends.

Technical corrections:

1) Page 5122. line 12: Tier 1 instead of Tire 1 2) Page 5123., line 24: I would propose: "Comparison with other anthropogenic SO<sub>2</sub> emission estimates.
