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The manuscript "Overview of the European framework for online integrated air quality and meteorology modelling (EuMetChem)" by Baklanov introduces the ACP/GMD inter-journal special issue "Coupled chemistry—meteorology modelling: status and relevance for numerical weather prediction, air quality and climate communities". According to the ACP Special issue guidelines, either a non-peer-reviewed editorial preface or a peer-reviewed scientific paper can be used to introduce a special issue. The current manuscript does not contain any scientific results, and I suggest to reject it. However, since it provides a useful overview of the special issue, I think it should be resubmitted as a non-peer-reviewed editorial preface.
